

Alex Palou: Champion

lex Palou was able to capitalize on a once-ina-lifetime opportunity.

Because of an unusual situation involving the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2021 Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach was moved from its traditional date in April to the end of the NTT INDYCAR SERIES season, creating one of the best settings to celebrate a career-defining moment.

The 24-year-old driver from Spain, driving the No. 10 NTT DATA Honda for Chip Ganassi Racing, started 10th and finished fourth in the final race of the 2021 season to claim the first in what he hopes will be many NTT INDYCAR SERIES championships.

"For me, it was amazing," said Palou, who turned 25 on April 1. "A championship is always a championship, but if you have the opportunity to celebrate it at one of the biggest events of the year, it makes it more and more special. It was a great weekend with lots of fans, a great event and it was awesome to celebrate around Long Beach.

"It had all of the good stuff of celebrating a championship at an amazing venue. I'm happy I got the opportunity to do that at Long Beach."

Palou was able to celebrate his first INDYCAR title in true Long Beach style. Although he is from Spain, Palou loves fried chicken after a race victory. Colton Herta of nearby Santa Clarita won the race, but champion Palou rewarded himself with a trip to one of Long Beach's more famous eateries the next morning with his favorite dish.

"At Long Beach, I got to celebrate at Roscoe's Chicken and Waffles on Monday morning," Palou said. "It was the perfect celebration after the championship. Then, we did media around the track and didn't get to go to other places. So, we had our championship celebration at Roscoe's.

It was Palou's first Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach, and he made the most of it.

"It is one of the best places to walk to the grid," Palou said. "There are some areas where we are



not around the fans and they can't see us, but all the fans are on the line where we have to go before jumping into the car."

On the track, Palou discovered the street course is quite a challenge, but the Spaniard has never met a challenge he couldn't face.

He quickly learned the art of racing the course in the early stages. Palou entered the race as the points leader with Pato O'Ward of Arrow McLaren SP second and Team Penske's Josef Newgarden third in the standings and the only drivers still in championship contention.

When O'Ward was involved in a multi-car crash in Turn 11, his championship hopes were over with a 27th-place finish. Newgarden raced his way up to second place, but Palou was just two cars behind at the finish to win the championship by 38 points.

"It's really tough," Palou said. "All of the street courses are tough. But the combination of long corners with really high braking zones makes it super, super tough. But it wasn't crazy difficult to pass. We had some overtakes there. We started 10th and finished in the top-five and did it on the track, so that was a lot of fun. It was a great track for racing and for overtakes while still being a street course.

A fast start to the 2021 season helped propel Palou to the INDYCAR SERIES championship. In the

2022 season-opening Firestone Grand Prix of St. Petersburg, Palou finished second to Team Penske's Scott McLaughlin, who won his first career INDYCAR race.

When Palou returns to Long Beach this weekend, it will have been just 6-1/2 months ago that he celebrated the title in this beautiful coastal city in Southern California.

Perhaps those memories can spur him on to his first win in the Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach.

If Palou is successful in defending his championship, he will accomplish a feat that hasn't happened in INDYCAR since Dario Franchitti won three-straight championships from 2009-2011.

"It's super tough in all sports, especially in INDYCAR," Palou said. "We'll do everything we can to make sure that happens again. I would say the key is to elevate our work, the level we delivered last year, and do it even better.

"But I'm hungrier than I was last year."

It's a hunger that only winning – and some fried chicken – can satisfy.



PRECISION CRAFTED PERFORMANCE

SCOTT MCLAUGHLIN

MAKING AN EARLY-SEASON SPLASH!



econd-year driver Scott McLaughlin almost came to the Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach with two straight wins.

On March 20, at the XPEL 375 at Texas Motor Speedway's XPEL 350, he started beside polesitter Felix Rosenqvist and went on to lead 186 laps ... losing only when teammate Josef Newgarden passed him on the final turn of the final lap and won by less than a tenth-of-a-second: .0669!

It was the 21st career race win for Newgarden, a two-time INDYCAR champion, 4th in the current point standings, who has finished 2nd in the last two races here at Long Beach.

Kicking off 2022, Mclaughlin led from the pole for 49 laps to win the season opening Firestone Grand Prix of St. Petersburg on Feb. 27.

The New Zealand native has delivered on the promise he showed Team Penske when it signed him straight from touring cars to the NTT INDYCAR SERIES. In 2021, he ran sixteen races, with five top-5 finishes and an 11th-place finish at Long Beach, earning Rookie of the Year honors.

Mclaughlin comes into this weekend holding a hefty series points lead with 97, ahead of Will Power (69), who was 4th at Texas after finishing 3rd at St. Petersburg.





Reigning INDYCAR champion Alex Palou was 7th at Texas after a 4th at St. Petersburg and holds down third place in the point standings. Defending Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach champion Colton Herta was 4th at St. Petersburg but faded to 12th at Texas, and stands tied for 7th in points with Marcus Ericsson, a podium-worthy 3rd at Texas.

Six-time INDYCAR champ Scott Dixon comes to Long Beach 6th in points after finishing 5th at Texas.

Another driver making news is seventime NASCAR Champion Jimmie Johnson, who, after struggling on road courses, made his oval track debut at Texas and took the checkered flag a solid 6th.

And, two-time Long Beach winner Alexander Rossi will be looking for a change in fortune after starting the season with results of 19th and 27th in the first two races.

The 85-lap 2022 Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach will take the green flag at 12:45 p.m. Sunday.

Newgarden won the March 20 race at Texas with a thrilling last lap/last corner pass of Team Penske teammate Scott McLaughlin. Last year, Newgarden logged two wins - Detroit and Elklhart Lake - and four poles to finish second in the standings to Alex Palou. He has scored two NTT INDYCAR SERIES championships - in 2017, his first season with Team Penske -and again in 2019. A 21-time IndyCar race winner, Newgarden had a career-best four wins in 2020, and his dominating win at lowa in 2016 set an INDYCAR record for most laps led by a race winner. He's a graduate of the Road to Indy, and won the 2011 Indy Lights championship with five race victories.

FAST-RISING STAR EYEING LONG BEACH REPEAT





t just 22 years of age, Colton Herta has emerged as one of America's most successful open-wheel racers.

Last year, in his third season of INDYCAR competition and driving for Andretti Autosport, Herta scored three victories and three poles, started on the front row and led 50% of the races, earning five podium finishes overall.

Of his several commanding performances in 2021, his win from the pole at St. Petersburg was dominant, as he led all but four laps. He closed the season with back-to-back victories in his home state of California at Laguna Seca and the Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach.

"I had so many satisfying moments in 2021," Herta says. "Wins at Laguna and here at Long Beach – particularly because I'm from California and grew up watching my Dad race – were incredibly special events for me."

Herta is the son of Bryan Herta, a former IndyCar driver who notched four race wins in his career, then went on to win two Indy 500s as a team owner. Currently, he's race strategist for his son on the Andretti Autosport w/Curb-Agajanian team.

In 2019, Herta became the youngest winning driver in INDYCAR history after his victory at Circuit of The Americas at 18 years, 359 days old. He also holds the record as youngest pole winner, at Road America, at 19 years, 83 days. He went on to collect a second victory at the season finale at Laguna Seca and two additional pole positions, finishing seventh in the championship standings.

Coming off his record-setting rookie season, Herta challenged for the 2020 title through the final race and finished third in the Championship with one victory, one pole, and 11 top-ten finishes.

Outside of INDYCARS, Colton also co-drove to victory in the 2019 Rolex 24 At Daytona and, in 2018, won the Indy Lights Freedom 100 at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, becoming the youngest driver to have won major events at two of America's most iconic tracks, Indianapolis Motor Speedway and Daytona International Speedway.

hree classes of the most advanced, exotic cars on the planet are set to meet Saturday in the 100-minute IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship!


Two drivers per car will get behind the wheel for three IMSA Classes: the Daytona Prototype International (DPi), the GTD Pro and the GT Daytona (GTD).

The fastest and most technologically advanced sports cars in North America, the DPi are designed for the racetrack. DPi cars use chassis built to international specifications powered by engines from mainstream automotive manufacturers like Acura, Cadillac and Mazda. In addition, DPi bodywork includes styling cues that align with these engine manufacturers.

After two races of the 2022 season, the JDC Motorsports team of Loic Duval, Richard Westbrook and Tristan Vautier are at the top of the DPi standings with 676 points. Matt Campbell. They hold a 668-655 points advantage over the Corvette-driving team of Nicky Catsburg, Antonio Garcia, and Jordan Taylor.

In the GTD Daytona class, Mike Skeen and Stevan McAleer have been racing in a Mercedes-AMG GT3. They are the team to beat with 53 more points than anyone else in the field.

The GT Daytona cars that will participate in both the GTD PRO and GTD classes use the same technical regulations. The only difference between the classes is the eligibility of all-pro driver lineups for GTD PRO versus required Pro-Am driver lineups in GTD. The cars are enhanced (not defined by) technology and utilize the global FIA-GT3 specification.

After Long Beach, the next IMSA competition is the weekend of May 29th at WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca in Monterey, California.

If that's your favorite kind of racing, it's back for two days of action at the Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach!

The SPEED/UTV Stadium SUPER Trucks series, founded by former INDYCAR/NASCAR driver Robby Gordon, kicks off its 2022 season with two battles on the city streets in identically-prepared, high-horsepower trucks.

Last year, Jarrett Brooks won the first race here, with Gordon taking race #2. Matt Brabham finished 2nd and 3rd but went on to win two races and the 2021 season championship, ahead of Gordon and Robert Stout.

It was Brabham's series-leading 3rd title. Gordon and

Sheldon Creed have each won two championships.

Returning to Long Beach after missing last year, Gavin Harlien won race #1 here in 2018, and his nine all-time victories rank 4th, behind Creed (38), Gordon (28) and Brabham (23).

Another driver to watch is fast-rising Max Gordon, Robby's 14-year-old son, who has been racing since he was 8 years old. Last year, despite no race wins, solid finishes enabled him to finish 4th in the driver series points.

The SUPER Trucks will go at it Saturday at 4:30 p.m. and Sunday at 3:30 p.m.

Following Long Beach, the series heads to the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course in Lexington for races July 1-3.



HISTORIC IMSA GTP CHALLENGE

ace fans will enjoy the sights - and sounds! - of sports car history when the Historic IMSA GTP Challenge hits the city streets this weekend.

Each of the cars will be authentic in every detail, including the livery they ran at the time. "These cars were part of so many classic moments in the 80s and 90s, so it'll be exciting to see them race for the very first time on the streets of Long Beach," said Cris Vandagriff, president of the Historic Motor Sports Association (HMSA), presenters of the GTP Challenge.

The HMSA is one of the most respected historic racing organizations in North America, producing world-class spectator events across the continent, and emphasizing the preservation and proper use of world-class race cars at all of its events.



ew to the Grand Prix, 34 Porsche Carrera Cup North America race cars will take to the track in two fierce, 40-minute races on Saturday and Sunday.

Every car competing in the Cup series is identical: the road car-based Porsche 911 GT3. Same make. Same model. Same generation. And, with no technical advantage between cars, driver talent, along with team mechanical skills and strategy, will be the factors that decide the race winner.

Holding eight races in the U.S. and Canada in 2022, the series kicked off its season with two races March 17 at Sebring, FL. And Kay van Berlo successfully swept the first two rounds. The second-year Pro class driver of the No. 3 Kelly-Moss Road and Race Porsche 911 GT3 Cup race car charged from pole position to victory lane in both the 40-minute season-opening rounds.

The pressure was hard at the front of the grid between Kelly-Moss teammates van Berlo – the 2021 series runner-up – and Riley Dickinson in the No. 53 along with JDX Racing's Parker Thompson in the No. 9. The trio finished on the podium in both races with Thompson in second place for Race 1, Dickinson moving to the second step of the podium in Race 2.





n Thursday, April 7, two multiple-race winners on the streets of Long Beach - Alex Zanardi and Bill Auberlen - were inducted into the Long Beach Motorsports Walk of Fame, a collaborative celebration with the City of Long Beach and Grand Prix Association of Long Beach.

The Walk of Fame is located on South Pine Ave., in front of the Long Beach Convention Center. The ceremony is part of the annual festivities surrounding the Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach.

Zanardi is an Italian racing legend who won the 1997 and 1998 Grands Prix of Long Beach, the same years he also won the CART Championship. A 15-time winner in Indy cars, Zanardi also had two stints driving in Formula One. In 2001, he was involved in a major crash in Germany, resulting in the

amputation of his legs. Less than two years later, he returned to racing and scored four wins in the World Touring Car Championship between 2005-09 driving a car with hand controls. He went on to become a champion in handcycling, winning a gold medal at the 2016 Paralympics in Rio de Janeiro. Since he is currently recuperating from a handcycling accident, Zanardi's former teammate, Jimmy Vasser, accepted the plague on his behalf.

Auberlen, a native and resident of Redondo Beach, is the International Motor Sport Association's (IMSA) all-time winningest driver, with 63 sports car wins and counting. At Long Beach, Auberlen was a class winner in 2013 (GT) and 2015 (GTLM), has been a class winner at the 24 Hours of Daytona twice (1997, '98) and finished in the top five twice at the 24 Hours of Le Mans. A six-time professional auto racing champion, Auberlen currently drives the #96 BMW M4 GT3 for Turner Motorsport in the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship.



Our green revolution continues. Terminal operators are deploying electric powered and zero-emissions cargo-handling equipment. We are transforming the drayage truck fleet to zero-emissions by 2035, funded by a Clean Truck Fund rate starting this spring.

In addition to new strides on the waterfront, the Port has also worked for more than 10 years to fund projects throughout the community to reduce the harmful effects of port operations, including air filters for classrooms, mobile health screenings, asthma education programs and tree plantings. The Long Beach Board of Harbor Commissioners has committed \$65 million for the Community Grants Program, the largest voluntary effort of its kind by any seaport in the United States.





Kevin Kalkhoven, whose motorsports involvement included co-ownership of racing series, teams, events and suppliers, died on January 4 at the age of 77 after a short illness.

Born in Adelaide, Australia, Kalkhoven first built his resources as CEO of JDS Uniphase, a leading technology company in Silicon Valley, then went on to become a highly successful venture capitalist and co-founder of KPLJ Ventures before emerging onto the motorsport landscape in 2003. In 2004, he, along with Championship Auto Racing Teams (CART) team owner Gerald Forsythe and Paul Gentilozzi, purchased CART's assets to form the Champ Car


World Series. Kalkhoven and Forsythe then purchased the Grand Prix of Long Beach and automotive engineering powerhouse Cosworth the following year.

In 2008, Kalkhoven helped negotiate the agreement that united the Indy Racing League and Champ Car to form today's NTT INDYCAR SERIES. As an INDYCAR team

owner, he helped lead Tony Kanaan's triumph at the 2013 Indianapolis 500. Besides the 500, his KV Racing Technology team with co-owner Jimmy Vasser won other Indy car races with drivers Cristiano da Matta (2005), Will Power (2008), and Sebastien Bourdais (four wins from 2014-16).

Away from the track, Kalkhoven remained Chairman of the now-merged Cosworth and Pi Research and oversaw the construction of Cosworth's North American base in Michigan. He was also an active philanthropist who served on the Board of Directors of the Association of Hole in the Wall Camps, which benefits children with serious medical conditions, was a benefactor to the Mayo Clinic, and also made significant donations to organizations such as the Canary Foundation, which focuses on early detection of cancer.

"The entire Grand Prix Association of Long Beach family is saddened to hear of the passing of our co-owner Kevin Kalkhoven," said Jim Michaelian, President and CEO of the Grand Prix Association of Long Beach. "He has provided strong support and visionary leadership over the past 16 years and his contributions to our company as well as to the racing community will be sorely missed. Our condolences go out to his wife Kimm and all of the Kalkhoven family. RIP, Kevin."




